

Materials List for Painting with Gouache Class

Mat board (optional) for gouache in middle tone gray or beige
Watercolor paper, cold press or rough surface

Gouache Tube Paints- (Design Gouache, not Acryl Gouache) I suggest **GRAHAM BRAND**

The **basic colors** you will need are

Cadmium Red (a red leaning towards orange –warm)
Permanent Rose (a red that leans towards purple – cooler)
Cadmium Yellow (a yellow that leans towards orange – warm)
Lemon (Hansa) Yellow (a yellow that leans towards green – cooler)
Ultramarine Blue (a blue that leans towards purple – warm)
Prussian Blue (a blue that leans towards green – cooler)
Raw Sienna
Burnt Sienna (a reddish brown)
White (Titanium) (a cool white)

(OR) If you prefer **more intense** colors in gouache, a boxed set of 12 **TURNER DESIGN GOUACHE** (not Acryl Gouache) paints- available on-line only at jerrysartarama.com)

Brushes for Gouache

Synthetic Watercolor brushes
Medium round (#8)
Small round (#4 or #6)
½” flat
¾” and/or 1” flat

Sundries

A mixing tray - enamel tray, palette or white china plate
Water container (clear plastic cookie containers work well for this)
Water spray bottle and sponge
Paper towel
Pencil (2B)
Kleenex tissues
