

## **Materials List for - Line and Wash**

### **Surfaces**

Hot press watercolor paper (This is my preferred surface for ink work). You can buy one large sheet and divide it into smaller pieces.

**OR** Watercolor paper cold press surface, (four pieces approx 9x12)

**OR** Watercolor Sketchbook (Moleskine)

**OR** Bristol Paper smooth surface (four pieces approx 9x12)

**OR** Cheap Joes American Journey Sketchbook (red cover)

### **Wet Media**

Dip Pen with metal nib for drawing (Speedball 56 or 99 nib or equivalent)

Bamboo pen - fine or med

India Ink (permanent)

Walnut ink

Higgins Eternal ink

Watercolors – selection of colors in a palette OR travel kit

Watercolor brushes (#6 and #8 round or equivalent)

Inexpensive synthetic brush (#6 OR #8 round or equivalent) for use with the inks ('Snap' brushes from Art Central would work well for this)

Water container

### **Sundries**

2b pencils x 2 - for sketching and eraser OR mechanical pencil
